From Atlanta take I-20 east to Exit 148 GA 22 (Crawfordville/Sparta). Turn right onto GA 22 and go south thru Powellton approx. 8.8 miles to Union Church Rd. Turn left onto Union Church Road and follow road thru Mayfield approx. 8.7 miles. A sign for Ogeechee River Mill will be on your left. Pass the sign and cross the river and take immediate left onto Reynolds Road. Pull up driveway. There will be volunteers there to greet you and direct you where to park, camp, put in boats etc.

From Athens take U.S. 78 East and South from Athens and travel approx. 19 miles to Lexington. Just south of Lexington turn right on GA 22 towards Crawfordville. Follow GA 22 South approx. 37 miles (cross over I-20) through Powellton to Union Church Road. Turn left onto Union Church Road and follow road thru Mayfield approx. 8.7 miles. A sign for Ogeechee River Mill will be on your left. Pass the sign and cross the river and take immediate left onto Reynolds Road. Pull up driveway. There will be volunteers there to greet you and direct you where to park, camp, put in boats etc.

From Macon go east on 49 thru Milledgeville, about 29 miles. Take GA 22 to Sparta (about 23 miles). Heading east through Sparta, take GA 16 for about 10 miles. Watch for green Mayfield sign on left. Turn left on Perry Bell Road and go to the end of the road (about 1.4 miles). Turn left at Hamburg State Park Road and go 2.5 miles. Cross RR tracks and turn right onto Union Church Road to mill. A sign for Ogeechee River Mill will be on your left. Pass the sign and cross the river and take immediate left onto Reynolds Road. Pull up driveway. There will be volunteers there to greet you and direct you where to park, camp, put in boats etc.

From Augusta take I-20 west to GA 80. Exit and turn left, and then go thru Camak to red light. Turn right, and go thru Warrenton to Atlanta hwy (US 278). Turn right and go only a short distance (.10 mile) and make a sharp left turn onto Mayfield Road. From there it is 10 miles to mill. Just before crossing the river, turn right onto Reynolds Road. Pull up driveway. There will be volunteers there to greet you and direct you where to park, camp, put in boats etc.
