Adopt 2025 Millage Rate

Resolution #2025-09-01

Chairman Graham informed the board that it is now time to set the 2025 Millage Rate. He stated that the tentative millage rate was set at 13.000 mills. He informed everyone that the five-year history, together with all necessary Public Hearing notices, had been publicly advertised in the local newspaper. He stated that the 2025 Net Digest would be \$236,987,645 and the 13.000 millage rate would generate total M&O taxes levied \$3,080,839, along with the Rollback being 2.0000. The projected FLPA reimbursement value for 2025 is \$185,000.00.


Chairman Graham noted that this is only the third time in the past 21 years that the millage rate has been raised. It is proposed that the millage rate be increased by 1 mill.


